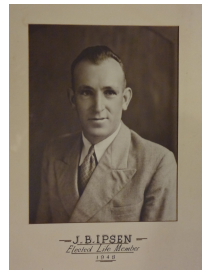

Fee \$50 per player for 36 holes entry

Fee must be paid before player tees off on Saturday

Pay via MiTournament when you register
Pay by EFT to Westpac BSB 036-126 Account 60-1957
(Please use your name as reference for EFT payments)

Details:

- \$50 entry is split amongst all 36 holes (after deducting 15% for the Manjimup Country Club Inc).
- The birdie jackpot works in skins format from hole 1 to 36 (in numerical order, from Saturday to Sunday).
- Birdie a hole to be eligible. Eagle trumps birdie, albatross trumps eagle.
- Gross scores only.
- All Par 3 birdies are paid out (separate jackpot).
- All birdies on hole 18 on Sunday are paid out, as no tie on the last hole.
- When the number of birdies on all other holes equals the tie number the hole is tied and jackpotted.
- The tie number is 10% of the number of players in the ultimate birdie jackpot, rounded up if required. For example, if the number of players in the jackpot is 44, the tie number is 5, which is 4.4 rounded up.
- All winnings will be EFT within one week.

- The match committee reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries and determine the method to obtain winners in the event of a tie.
- No player is eligible for more than one trophy.
- Preferred tee times cannot be guaranteed.
- Entry fees are not refunded after the draw has been posted on the web site (about one week prior to event).
- Meals included for players, meals can be purchased for guests and non-players, Friday night \$30, Saturday night \$50, Sunday \$15.
- Breakfast is not catered for at the club.
- Trophies held for 3 months after the tournament. Please make your own arrangements for collection.
- Please note that no BYO liquor is permitted.
- Please make your own arrangements with golf carts.
